ANTH 102 is an introduction to basic concepts, methods, and history of ideas of social and cultural anthropology. The emphasis is on understanding anthropological explanations of economic, social, and ceremonial activities of small-scale societies dutside of the experience of most Canadians. The role of the study of languages in anthropology will also be discussed. Focused individual and group discussions based on assigned readings and study questions are an important part of ANTH 102, and will be a part of classroom interaction. Expect to participate in class discussions of reading assignments and videos, and to write an essay. Note: ANTH 102 is a basic foundation course, and is a prerequisite to several upper-level Anthropology courses.


