Ethical concerns with ChatGPT

- “We are a little bit scared” – OpenAI CEO
- Is ChatGPT biased? Yes, says OpenAI.
- AI workers experience harm
- Environmental impact of the AI cloud
- Is ChatGPT the world's biggest copyright scam?
- Privacy risks – queries leaked to other users
- Lack of transparency - "open" in name only

ChatGPT “Vision”

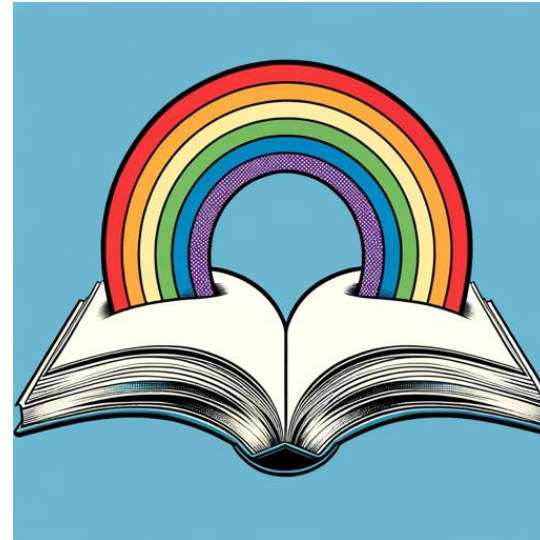
- Recently released on ChatGPT Plus

- "Write alt text" had amazing results

What is Alt Text Assistant?

I am Alt Text Assistant, a specialized version of ChatGPT designed to create concise alt text for educational images. My aim is to provide descriptions that are screen reader friendly, typically within 200 characters, ensuring that the alt text is accurate and adheres to accessibility standards. If I need more context to refine the alt text, I'll ask for the webpage URL containing the image. I maintain a friendly and professional tone throughout our interactions.

Alt Text Assistant capabilities

- Can interpret images
- Can search and browse the web
- Can take feedback
- Cannot replace an expert
